Description:

- Participate in the initial machinery development process.
- Provide input on concept requirements, complexity, and cost.
- Design and lay out electrical systems which are NFPA79/NEC/UL508A compliant.
- Create electrical, pneumatic, and fluid schematics in AutoCAD Electrical.
- Write and debug PLC programs using Structured Text and Ladder Logic with an emphasis on generating code that is organized, structured, documented, maintainable and reusable.
- Implement (CSA/ANSI/OSHA compliant) control reliable safety systems for safeguarding machinery.
- Select and size electrical and electromechanical components such as servos.
- Generate aesthetically simple HMI screens for complex machinery while providing sufficient feedback for troubleshooting.
- Produce electrical design/program changes to support custom machinery orders, existing product improvements and change requests for assigned product lines.
- Provide timely, complete, and consistent technical support to internal and external business customers as required for assigned product lines.
- Train internal staff and end user teams to operate and maintain new machinery after development.
- Manage electrical cabinet builds, field wiring, pneumatic and fluid plumbing.
- Create and maintain machinery operation and troubleshooting manuals.

- Hands on experience with electromechanical / mechatronic systems.
- In depth knowledge of Electrical Standards (NFPA79, National Electric code, UL508A).
- In depth knowledge of Safety standards (ANSI/RIA15.06, OSHA).
- Advanced proficiency programming industrial equipment:
 - Utilizing Structured Text and Ladder Logic.
 - o PLCs (B&R, Mitsubishi, AB and Siemens)
 - Safety PLCs (B&R, Sick)
 - o Human Machine Interface (B&R, Mitsubishi, AB)
 - Field bus Networks (Powerlink, IO-Link, Ethernet/IP)
 - o Serial communication (RS-232) between PLCs and instruments
- Ability to program state machines for complex processes which involve multi-station parallel processing, data acquisition and PID control.
