

Junior Manufacturing Coordinator

Description:

This role is a working fabrication department position, that aids scheduling with the delivery of job order and job order priorities and fabrication departments. The role prepares blanks for machining operations, organizes the priority order of machine shop work, pulls and cuts raw materials for next machine/fabrication operation. It also oversees 3D printing work centres.

Tasks also include laying out parts/drawings for each JO, ordering the jobs in proper sequence per work centre, reviewing completed work and following up on and preparing materials for post ops such as anodizing and paint.

The Coordinator is confident and proficient with machine shop equipment such as drill-press, band saw, bench grinders and hand tools such as nail gun, circular saw, and tape measure.

Responsible for work flow, material assessment, meeting schedules.

A leader in the machine and fabrication shops, motivating and facilitating work for the employees. Must work well with, and adhere to, scheduled work timelines as provided by production scheduler, engineering, and/or operations head. Will work closely with shop/fabrication employees, engineering and management. Some OT may be required when necessary.

Responsibilities:

In addition to direct working machine shop labour duties:

- Work closely with Scheduling & Materials Manager to report issues regarding material availability and assigns specific jobs to machinists.
- Manages work flow and ensures all machinists have work for all shifts.
- Manages scrap allocations and assures proper disposal.
- Ensures administrative and work procedures are followed.
- Ensures safe work practices are followed..
- Periodic cycle counting of inventory.
- Reporting and management of damaged or incorrect inventories.
- Provides suggestions for improvements and provides feedback of workflow to Production Scheduler.
- Must be available for overtime when assigned in accordance with ESA standards.
- Other duties as assigned.

- Capable of lifting 25kg
- Basic math skills and familiarity with dimensional measurements
- Familiarity in machine shop environment
- Experience reading part blue prints and understanding dimensions
- Good oral communication skills to understand verbal instructions
- Willingness to work overtime when required
- Ability to work independently
